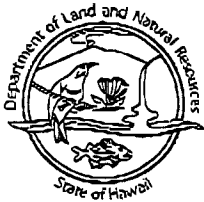

Dear Interested Party:

The Division of State Parks will present to the Board of Land and Natural Resources the various management options under consideration for the Kōke'e and Waimea Canyon State Parks Master Plan, including a recommendation to the Board on the disposition of the recreation residence lots.

At the October 14, 2003 public information meeting held at the Līhu'e Neighborhood Center, it was announced that the parks Master Plan and recreation residence issues would be taken to the Board at a meeting to be held on Kaua'i. We regret to inform you that the meeting location was changed to Honolulu, O'ahu.

One of a number of items that will be presented for review and approval by the Board are the recommendations for the future of the recreation residences. There will be a Board briefing on November 4, 2003 beginning at 2:00 p.m., and a Board meeting on November 5, 2003, beginning at 9:00 a.m., in the Boardroom of the Kalanimoku Building, located at 1151 Punchbowl St., room 131, Honolulu, Hawai'i. The public may give testimony at the Board briefing and Board meeting and may also submit written testimony.

We have enclosed the notes from the October 9, 2002 and October 14, 2003 public information meetings and the results of the voting that was conducted for the alternative plans for the management of the parks and the alternatives for the recreation residences.
