The Division of State Parks will hold the second public information meeting on the Master Plan for Köke'e and Waimea Canyon State Parks. The meeting will be held on:

The objectives for this meeting are to present three alternatives for the development of the two parks. The Köke' e Interagency Task Force, comprised of representatives from the divisions within the Department that have jurisdictional responsibilities in the surrounding areas, has developed a preferred alternative that will also be presented at this meeting. Public input on these alternatives will result in the formulation of a final preferred alternative and recommending actions for the management, enhancement and development of Köke'e and Waimea Canyon State Parks for the next twenty-five years. Resource conservation, public recreation, the future of the recreation residences, existing water and sewage systems, and revenue generation are some of the primary issues that are being addressed in the Plan.
